



NATTARO SCOUT™

Guide for successful bed bug detection

Nattaro Scout is a Swedish innovative device for early detection and ongoing monitoring of bed bugs which is efficient at low levels of bed bug infestations. The lure mimics the natural smell of a bed bug harborage/aggregation (bed bug home) and attracts males and females as well as all nymph stages.

Nattaro Scout is a valuable tool for an Integrated Pest Management approach to control bed bugs.



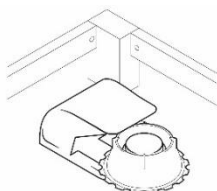
- For early detection of low-level infestations
- For quality assurance following a treatment
- For monitoring in environments with a high risk of infestation

User instructions

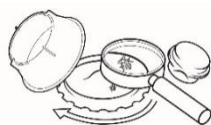
9 out of 10 bed bug infestations originate in the bed, begin the search here. Make a quick visual inspection of the bed and linen. Look for shreds of light brown skin remains and black spots (faeces) along mattress seams and bed frame. Position 2 or more traps per suspected object. For optimal detection place the detector inside the bed, under the mattress. Alternatively it can be placed by the legs or tied to a leg or under the bed frame. Choose the darkest corner of the bed.



Open the white bag and place the lure inside the trap.
Do not try to open the lure, the scent is emitted through the plastic.



Slide into holder. Place traps in the darkest corners of a sleeping place, ideally under the mattress, alternatively on the floor.
Keep away from children and pets.



Check the outside and inside of the trap and the area around the trap regularly.
Replace the lure every 4 weeks.

We recommend that a confirmed bed bug infestation is treated by a professional pest control company.

Warning: Do not try to open the lure container. The lure liquid contains 2-hexenal which can cause allergic reactions in direct contact, see Material Safety Data Sheet.
